Sealed bids will be received at the Victor Valley College Facilities Construction office, Administration Building #10; 18422 Bear Valley Road, Victorville, California 92395, **until 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 8, 2022** at which time said bids will be opened and read aloud in a virtual Zoom meeting, a meeting link will be provided on our VVC Facilities project updates webpage <https://www.vvc.edu/project-updates>

All bids shall be made and submitted on the bid form furnished by the District. Each bid must conform with and be responsive to all pertinent bidding and contract documents, copies of which are on file and may be obtained from the office of Facilities Construction or on the webpage <https://www.vvc.edu/project-updates>

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Form, Bid Bond, Subcontractors List, Proof of registration with the Department of Industrial Relations by both contractor and proposed subcontractors pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5, Non-Collusion Affidavit, Certification of Workers' Compensation, and Agreement and Certification of Drug-Free Workplace. A payment bond and performance bond will be required prior to the execution of the contract. The District reserves the right to reject, as non-responsive, any bid submitted without these forms completed. The District also reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive irregularities in any bid. There will be no engineers estimate available.
