
BOARD POLICIES Chapter 2, Board of Trustees



BP 2010 Board Membership

The Board shall consist of 5 members elected by the qualified voters of the District. Members shall be elected by trustee are as defined in BP 2100, Board Elections.

Any person who meets the criteria contained in law is eligible to be elected or appointed a member of the Board.

An employee of the District may not be sworn into office as an elected or appointed member of the governing Board unless he/she/they resigns as an employee. If the employee does not resign, the employment will automatically terminate upon being sworn into office. (Noted in EC 72103 (b)(1).

No member of the governing Board shall, during the term for which he/she/they is elected, hold an incompatible office. Incompatible Offices are addressed in Gov. Code Section 1099 which codifies the common law prohibition against the holding of "incompatible public offices". This doctrine restricts the ability of public officials to hold two different public offices simultaneously if the offices have overlapping and conflicting public duties.

No member of the governing board of a community college district shall, during the term for which he/she/they was elected, be eligible to serve on the governing board of a high school district whose boundaries are coterminous with those of the community college district.
