- 3. In accordance with Executive Order 595, students admitted to any CSU with full or partial certification will not be held to any additional lower-division general
- education requirements in the areas certified. Students may be held to other lower division graduation requirements.
- 4. Full Certification All areas completed with a minimum of 39 units.
- 5. Partial GE Certification before transfer can be provided in any Area. Full Certification after transfer is subject to the particular rules of the receiving university.
- If not fully certified before transfer, students may be required to complete the general education pattern of the specific campus to which they transfer.
 Students must request certification by completing the "CSU and UC General Education Certification" form available in Counseling or in the Transfer Center.

Important Points:

- 1. A minimum of 9 additional semester units of upper-division general education must be completed at the CSU campus.
- If a student completes a course in a year it did not appear on the CSU General Education course list, it cannot be used for GE certification.
 A minimum of 60 units of transferable courses must be completed to transfer as a junior.
- Credit is awarded for either an honors or non-honors course, not both. For example, students may receive credit for Math 105 or Math 105H, not both.
 A single course may not fulfill more than one general education requirement even though it may be listed in more than one area.
