



AP 3500 Campus Safety

A Campus Safety Plan shall be developed and made available on the Campus Police website.

The Chief of Police prepares and annually updates a report of all occurrences reported to the Campus Police Department that outlines the campus safety procedures and address reported incidents of campus safety as well as accounts for arrests for crimes that are committed on campus, specific acts of crime and violence, hate crimes, theft, vandalism, illegal drugs, alcohol intoxication, and sex offenses. Additionally, the report addressed occurrences of noncriminal acts of hate incidents reported to campus authorities. Written records of noncriminal acts of hate incidents as defined in Education Code 67380 shall include at least a description of the act of hate violence and a detailed investigation into the incident.

A copy of the annual report will be provided to the Board of Trustee each year.
