5.3 Revolving Cash Fund Increase

Approval to increase the Revolving Cash Fund. This increase is necessary to pay for athletic expenses, pre-paid expenses for employees who attend conferences, and other miscellaneous expenses that must be processed immediately. Fiscal Impact: \$20,000.00 from the General Fund.

5.4 Memorandum of Understanding – Excelsior Charter Schools

Ratification of the Memorandum of Understanding with Excelsior Charter Schools for the purpose of approving the use of Victor Valley College's athletic fields. The term of this agreement is from September 14, 2011 through June 30, 2012. Fiscal Impact: None.

5.5 <u>Change Order – Air-Ex Air Conditioning, Inc. – Main Gymnasium H.V.A.C.</u>
Replacement

Ratification of the Change Order No. 01 from Air-Ex Air Conditioning, Inc. The Main Gymnasium H.V.A.C. Replacement project came in under budget by \$25,053.48 and will be deducted from the original contract amount. Fiscal Impact: \$25,053.48, credit to the district.

5.6 Award Contract - Portable Building Roof Repair

Approval to award the contract to Wiltshire Urethane Foam Company for roof repair for buildings 12B and 12C occupied by the County of San Bernardino's Head Start Child Care Program. Fiscal Impact: \$38,640.00, Fund 71.

5.7 Agreement - Hi Desert Alarm

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Hi Desert Alarm to install and provide monitoring of the alarm system for the Public Safety Training Center. Fiscal Impact: \$25,700.00, Local Bond Funded.

Additional Services Agreement - Frick, Frick & Jette Architects, Inc. 5.8

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Frick, Frick & Jette Architects, Inc. to provide additional architectural design and engineering services for a tear drop round-about at the main entrance of the campus on Jacaranda Road to enhance commuter safety and convenient access to the west side of campus. Fiscal Impact: \$36,700.00.

Amend Agreement - Merrell-Johnson Engineering, Inc. 5.9

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Merrell-Johnson Engineering, Inc. for laboratory and on-site testing services during the construction of the Eastside Public Safety Training Center. Fiscal Impact: Estimated at \$53,796.00, Local Bond Funded (This funding is within the original budget of \$31,536,982.00 for the Public Safety Training Center project.)

5.10 Agreement - American Fire Safety, Inc.

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and American Fire Safety, Inc. to provide services for fire sprinkler repairs in 10 campus buildings. Fiscal Impact: \$29,822.00, Fund 71.

5.11 Agreement - D&G Flooring, Inc.

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and D&G Flooring, Inc. to provide materials and labor to install the new carpet in the relocated Foundation Office in building 55. Fiscal Impact: \$3,949.18, Fund 71.

5.12 Agreement - PumpMan, Inc.

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and PumpMan, Inc. to provide repair services for waste water lift pumps that service Buildings 90 through 94 on the lower campus. Fiscal Impact: \$1,399.00, Fund 71.

5.13 Agreement - Vector Resources, Inc.

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Vector Resources, Inc. to purchase equipment to upgrade the existing Cisco Access Control Server (ACS). This upgrade will allow employees and students to access many related databases with one log-in entry; currently multiple logins are required. Fiscal Impact: \$9,414.12, Fund 71.

5.14 Agreement - Vector Resources, Inc.

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Vector Resources, Inc. to purchase updated classroom instructional equipment for the main campus. Fiscal Impact: \$15,377.65, Fund 71.

5.15 Agreement - Active Data Exchange

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Active Data Exchange to purchase enterprise-level calendaring software for the college's master calendar. Fiscal Impact: \$10,128.00, budgeted item.

Ratification of an Independent Contractor Agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Julianne Pehkonen to provide Perkins grant technical assistance and training workshops on topics such as core indicator measures and special populations. The period of this agreement is from August 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012. Fiscal Impact: Not to exceed \$15,000, budgeted item, grant funded, Perkins.

5.23 Independent Contractor Agreement - Maria Elena Huizar

Ratification of an Independent Contractor Agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Maria Elena Huizar to provide parenting workshops to GEAR UP program high schools.
