5.2 Notice of Completion - Cooley Construction

Ratification of the Notice of Completion with Cooley Construction for the drainage channel repair project. This agreement was originally Board approved on August 13, 2013. Fiscal Impact: None

5.3 Agreement - Merrell Johnson Companies

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Merrell Johnson Companies to use the three (3) year agreement, that was originally approved by the Board on April 9, 2013, to assist with the Stormwater Multiple Application and Report Tracking Systems (SMARTS) process pertaining to the Health/Science Building project. Fiscal Impact: \$13,800.00, bond funded.

5.4 Agreement - Merrell Johnson Companies

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Merrell Johnson Companies to use the three (3) year agreement, that was originally approved by the Board on April 9, 2013, for materials testing and special inspection services needed during the drainage channel repair project. Fiscal Impact: \$12,262.50, Fund 71.

5.5 Site Ground Lease Agreement – Excelsior Education Center

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Excelsior Education Center for school purposes as authorized by the Charter Agreement between Victor Valley Union High School District and Excelsior Education Center. Excelsior currently leases 3.64 acres from the District. Fiscal Impact: \$3,264.00, monthly, \$39,168.00 annually, to increase by 3% annually, **Revenue to the District**.

5.6 Agreement – A&E Inspection Services

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and A&E Inspection Services to use the existing three (3) year agreement, that was originally approved by the Board on April 12, 2011, to provide Inspector of Record services needed during the drainage channel repair project. Fiscal Impact: Not to exceed \$2,000.00, Fund 71.

5.8 Agreement Renewal - Datawatch

Ratification of the renewal agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Datawatch for one year to continue maintenance support for Monarch software. This product provides the capability to extract, analyze and export data from existing reports without programming. Monarch also lets users combine and import data from additional data sources, such as databases or spreadsheets. Term: 11/2/13-11/1/14. Fiscal Impact: \$3,879.20, budgeted item.

5.9 Agreement- Dell, Inc.

Ratification of the renewal agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Dell, Inc. for the purchase of 10 hours of remote professional services for the configuration of SQL in regards to KACE. (Item #IN-62, on the Campus Technology Project list). Fiscal Impact: Not to exceed \$2,500.00, budgeted item.

5.10 Agreement Renewal - Visual Click Software, Inc.

Ratification of the renewal agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Visual Click Software, Inc. for licensing that will allow us to monitor servers at Victor Valley College, this includes support and maintenance. Term: 10/1/13-6/2/14. Fiscal Impact: \$1,906.67, budgeted item.

5.11 Agreement Renewal - Evisions

Ratification of the renewal agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Evisions for maintenance and support for Form Fusion software. Term: 11/1/13-10/31/14. Fiscal Impact: \$3,662.00, budgeted item.

5.12 Agreement - Metalogix International

Ratification of the renewal agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Metalogix International for the purchase of ControlPoint software license along with a three year support. This software will facilitate the migration of data across SharePoint farms. Term: 10/1/13-9/30/16. (Item #IN-61, on the Campus Technology Project list). Fiscal Impact: \$13,200.00, Fund 71.

5.13 <u>HIPAA Business Associate Amended Agreement - California Department of Veteran's</u>
Affairs

Ratification of the amended agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and California Department of Veteran's Affairs to provide confidentiality of patient information for Registered Nursing and other Health Sciences programs of the District. Fiscal Impact: None.

5.14 Class Fee Increase - Fire Technology - FIRE 95

Approval of the fee increase for Fire 95, Basic Fire Academy Class, from \$300 to \$580 to provide each student with NFPA Compliant Personal Protective Equipment. The students will keep their nomex hood, firefighting gloves, equipment bags, student manuals and notebooks. This fee will also offset the State Fire Training increase for certification from \$5 to \$20 per student. This increase will be effective with the Spring 2014 semester. Fiscal Impact: None

5.15 Class Fee Increase – Fire Technology – FIRE 63
Approval of the fee increase for Fire 63, Apparatus Driver Operator 1A Class, from \$100 to \$150 to provide the student with certification, student manual and newly mandated driver handbook. There has also been an increase in student certification from \$50 to \$80. This increase will be effective with the Winter 2014 semester. Fiscal Impact: None

5.16 Class Fee Increase – Fire Technology – FIRE 64
Approval of the fee increase for Fire 64, Apparatus Driver Operator 1B Class, from \$100 to \$150 to provide the student with certification, student manual and binder. This will offset the cost of a State Fire Training increase for certification from \$50 to \$80. This increase will be effective with the Winter 2014 semester. Fiscal Impact: None.

5.17 Class Fee Increase – Fire Technology – FIRE 11D
Approval of the fee increase for Fire 11D, Confined Space Rescue Technician Class, from \$300 to \$350 to provide the student with an intrinsically safe flashlight, knee pads and approved hand protection required for confined space entry. The student will also be provided a certification, student manual and notebook. This fee will also offset the increase in certification from \$50 to \$80. This increase will be effective with the Winter 2014 semester. Fiscal Impact: None.

5.18 Agreement – Beckman Coulter
Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and
Beckman Coulter for the servicing of equipment used in the Biology Department. The period
of this agreement is November 15, 2013 through November 14, 2014. Fiscal Impact:
\$1,719.73, budgeted item.

Agreement— ECMC Solutions Corporation
Ratification of the renewal agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and ECMC Solutions Corporation to provide to delinquent borrowers, a combination of delinquency counseling services and features. The period of this agreement is October 15, 2013 and will automatically renew for successive one-year terms unless either party notifies the other in writing, at least 30 days prior to the end of the renewal term. Fiscal Impact: Not to exceed \$30,000.00, BFAP funded, budgeted item.

- 5.20 Agreement Child Development Training Consortium -Yosemite Community College District Ratification of the Child Development Training Consortium agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Yosemite Community College District. This agreement is a continuum of the 2012-2013 agreement. The grant program benefits students who are currently employed in early childhood setting, encouraging them to return to school to further their education and increase their skill by assisting them in their tuition and textbook expenses. The term of this agreement is September 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014. Fiscal Impact: \$9,375.00 Income to the District.
- 5.21 <u>Agreement California Early Childhood Mentor Program Chabot-Las Positas Community College District</u>

Ratification of the agreement between Victor Valley Community College District and Chabot-Las Positas Community College District, on behalf of its California Early Childhood Mentor Program for the 2012-2013 academic year. Through this contract mentors are selected from a variety of early childhood programs in the high desert. The students will be placed in these programs for the lab hours necessary for completion of CHDV 210. The period of this agreement is from August 1, 2013 through July 31, 2014. Fiscal Impact: None
