
## **BOARD POLICIES**Chapter 5, Student Services



## **BP 5015** Residence Determination

Students shall be classified at the time of each application for admission or registration as a resident or nonresident student.

- A resident is any person who has been a bona fide resident of California for at least one year on the residence determination date.
- The residence determination date shall be the day immediately preceding the first day of a semester or summer session for which the student applies to attend.
- Residence classification shall be made for each student at the time of initial
  application and whenever a student has not been in attendance for more than one
  semester.
- A student previously classified as a nonresident may be reclassified on or before the residency determination date by providing appropriate documentation.

The Superintendent/President shall enact procedures to assure that residence determinations are made in accordance with Education Code and Title 5 regulations.
