Whereas, There is a need for the development of a plan that outlines the goals and objectives as well as a timeline and a budget for implementing the Non-Credit policies, procedures, programs and support services that are required in order to provide a quality Math and English Basic Skills Non-Credit Program at Victor Valley Community College;

**Whereas,** The Math and English curricular program implementation of AB-705 at Victor Valley College no longer provides academic resources for those students that enter far below college level preparedness in Math and English;

**Resolved**, That the Academic Senate supports research and development of support structures in order to provide a quality Math and English Basic Skills Non-Credit Program that addresses the academic preparation needs of those students that self-identify as not likely to be successful in a traditional college level Math and English program.
