 - The IPRC reviewed the definition of a program at VVC that has been proposed.
 The committee made a few edits and formally recommends to the Academic Senate the following:

Definition of an Instructional Program for the Purpose of Program Review

For the purpose of Program Review, an "instructional program" is defined as an organizationally distinct planning and evaluation unit with formally recognized leadership (chair, coordinator, facilitator), which is specified in the Program List, and an identified function, mission, and/or purpose. A program may consist of a single discipline or a group of related disciplines which share joint leadership and academic purposes.

 The IPRC also reviewed the proposed definition of a program for assessment purposes. The committee agrees with the proposal and formally recommends to the SLOAC the following for consideration:

Definition of an Instructional Program for the Purpose of Program Learning Assessment

For the purpose of program learning assessment practice and reporting, an "instructional program" is a defined sequence or grouping of courses within a discipline required for the completion of a major, degree, or certificate at Victor Valley College.
